



CHILD'S TRADITIONAL STYLE PICNIC TABLE

These plans for a classic style children's picnic table are simple and the finished product will be sturdy yet inexpensive. Designed to utilize standard materials available at your local hardware or lumber store. This project can be completed in about 4 hours.

ITEM #	QTY	DESCRIPTION
1	1	2" x 6" x 8'-0" LONG REDWOOD OR CEDAR
2	7	2" x 4" x 8'-0" LONG REDWOOD OR CEDAR
3	12	3/8" DIAMETER x 3-1/2" LONG CARRIAGE BOLT W/ NUTS & WASHERS, GALVANIZED
4	100	#8 x 2-1/2" EXTERIOR GRADE DECK SCREWS, STAINLESS STEEL

When the table is complete, use a belt sander to smooth out all sharp edges. If the table will be subjected to adverse weather conditions, wood treatment is recommended. After you have completed this project, order the full size picnic table for the adults.

ALL PARTS OF THE CHILD'S PICNIC TABLE THAT COULD BE IN CONTACT WITH THE CHILDREN SHOULD NOT BE PRESSURE TREATED. SOME PRESSURE TREATMENT CHEMICALS ARE HAZARDOUS.

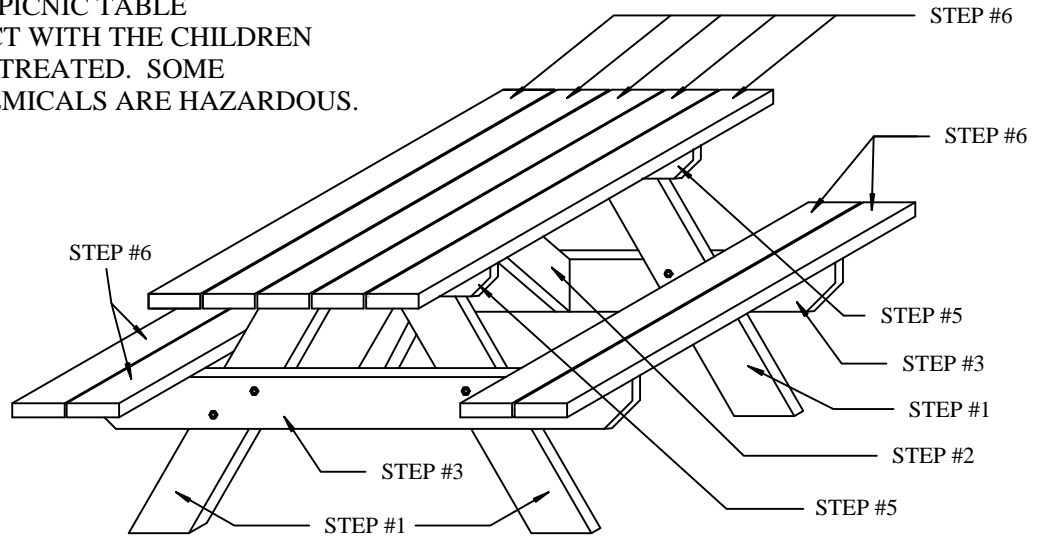


Figure #1 - Isometric Assembled Table

Make (4) Legs per Figure #2. Holes for bolts will be drilled later.

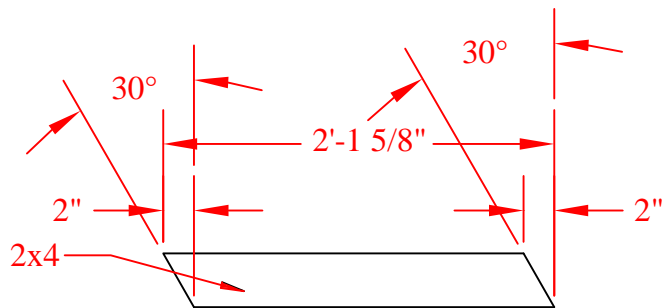


Figure #2 - Leg

STEP #2

Make (2) Diagonal Braces per Figure #3.

NOTE: ALL CUT ANGLES ARE 45°

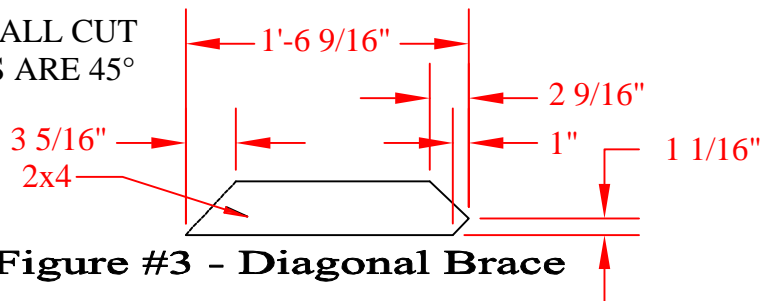


Figure #3 - Diagonal Brace
